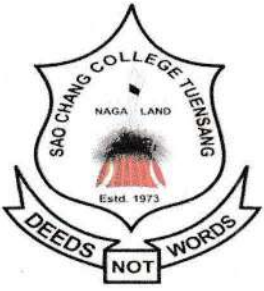

EXTENSION SERVICE		
1.	To conduct an extension service on World Environment Day in collaboration with the Zoology Department of Sao Chang College.	Conducted on 5th June 2023 Venue- Govt. Middle School, Chendang Village Participants – 47 participants The event was marked by a “Solution to Plastic Pollution” seminar, with 47 participants from School Management Committee and School Parents Association. Rangbenkumla Chang, Asst Professor, Dept of Environmental Science, SCC spoke on the theme while Vidila Jing, Asst Professor, Dept of Zoology, SCC led the plantation drive where 50 students participated. It is noted that Alemwapang ACF (DFO Longleng) provided the saplings and Yingli Mission Society Nagaland partly sponsored the event.
FIELD STUDY		
2.	To conduct a field study as part of the EVS curriculum (Old Course)	Conducted on 25th March 2024 Venue- Aüching Village, Longleng Participants – 178 students along with 4 faculties (Rangbenkumla Chang, Dr Limamanem Phom, K Vidila Jing and Dr Soyimla) The study topic was ‘Community participation in Biodiversity conservation and Livelihood enhancement’. Speaking to the students, resource person Dr. Y Nuklu Phom (Team Leader, LEMSACHENLOK) emphasized on the importance of sustainability in any venture. He highlighted the MODELS they employ in their intervention on Biodiversity conservation and

		Livelihood enhancement measures through Community involvement. The department is grateful to Leaders of Aüching village and the LEMSACHENLOK Team for sharing their knowledge. The department also thank 3rd NAP, IR 9th Coy, ITI, DEF for generously providing their buses which made this field trip possible.
ACTIVITY		
3.	To commemorate International Biodiversity Day	Conducted on 22nd May 2024 Venue- Mount Carmel School, Tuensang Participants – 45 participants (students of classes 6 and 7, and teaching faculty) The activity centered around the theme “Be Part of the Plan,” the initiative focused on beautifying the school campus to enhance its aesthetic and functional aspects. A total of 45 participants, including faculty members and students from classes 6 and 7, took part in the event. The department extends its gratitude to Krishi Vigyan Kendra Tuensang for sponsoring the pine saplings and to Sao Chang College RUSA (Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan) for providing the flower saplings, prepared by the 6th batch of floriculture students.
4.	To collaborate with the Sociology Department of Sao Chang College	Conducted on 1st May 2024 Venue- Baptist School, Tuensang Village Participants – 14 participants The event saw the participation of 14 teachers. Ms. Y Toninaro Chongpho, Assistant Professor and Head of the Sociology Department at Sao Chang College, led the first session, discussing the theme "Teachers as Role Models." The second session, focusing on "Nurturing Emotional Intelligence to Address Teacher Burnout," was conducted by Ms. Rangbenkumla Chang, Assistant Professor and Head of the Environmental Science Department at Sao Chang College.
