

The Cultural and Literary Day festivities held on 24th February, 2024, were jointly organized by the Literary and Magazine Committee of Sao Chang College in collaboration with the Cultural Committee. Among the array of activities, the Literary and Magazine Committee orchestrated a Folklore Elocution Competition to uphold the Literary Day. This event was designed to commemorate the venerable tradition of oral storytelling and to foster cultural interchange among the student body.

Participants: A total of 10 participants from various academic disciplines took part in the competition. Each participant showcased their storytelling skills by narrating folklore from different cultures.


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
