

INTRODUCTION OF THE COLLEGE

(Brief information about the College)

Sao Chang College is named after Late H. Sao Chang, former Minister for Transport |& Communication and Public Health Education Department (PHED), Government of Nagaland. The cherished aspiration for higher education of the people of Tuensang district saw its light with a humble beginning as 'Tuensang Night College' (Arts) in 1973 at a designated temporary building at Tuensang Town. To accommodate the increasing enrolment of students seeking for higher education within the district, the college was elevated to a regular day shift college. Subsequently, the college was taken over by the Government of Nagaland in April 1983. Shifted in the year 1996, the college presently has its own permanent campus at a distance of about 9 kilometers away from Tuensang town. Science stream was later introduced in 2005. Located amidst splendid and lofty mountain ranges and a pervading atmosphere of serenity, the college is ideal and conducive to be a centre of higher learning.

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

Keeping in view the importance of Assessment and Accreditation of Higher Education Institutes, Sao Chang College had long been striving to be accredited by NAAC. In this regard, the IQAC,Sao Chang College had been sincerely initiating and aspiring for early accreditation of the college despite its numerous shortcomings. Eventually, the NAAC Peer Team visited the College on the 11th and 12th March 2020. The three-member Peer Team was headed by Prof. Bishnu Charan Barik, former Vice Chancellor, Sambalpur University, as the Chairperson. 


1. LIBRARY

3. NSS, NCC.

The National Cadet Corps (NCC), Sao Chang College, has been actively engaged in various activities all throughout the Academic year. During the Covid-19 Pandemic, the NCC Cadets of the College hosted a brief online program to commemorate World Environment Day on 5th June 2020. Online Yoga Day was observed on 21st June 2020 in which the NCC Cadets participated actively. A mini-camp was organized by the Assam Rifles from 23rd to 27th February 2021 wherein a total of 25 Cadets attended. During the mini-camp, the Cadets took part in various trainings like drill practice, map reading and weapon firing competition. Sao Chang College NSS unit have been actively involved in community services especially during the Covid-19 pandemic by organizing various programs and activities. To disseminate awareness on stigma against Covid-19 frontline workers and persons affected with the pandemic, the NSS volunteers of the college organized an awareness program by circulating posters and posted messages in various whatsapp groups. The volunteers also translated wall posters on awareness of Covid-19 in four local dialects and pasted them in strategic locations for public consumption in Tuensang town. As a part of Fit India Youth Club program, on 15th August 2020, the NSS volunteers of the college took part in aerobic and Yoga stretching exercises. On 2nd October 2020, Gandhi Jayanti was observed by the NSS unit by conducting a cleanliness drive and tree plantation. 'Earth Day' was observed on 22nd April 2021 by the NSS unit of the college and to mark the occasion a mini-garden was prepared and flowers were planted during which fifteen NSS volunteers and three teachers also took part. The Red Ribbon Club of the college took active part during the International Youth Day 2020 and as a part of the celebration two members of the college Red Ribbon Club participated in the online 'spoken word competition'.

5. STUDENTS WELFARE INITIATIVES

The main objective of the Student's Welfare Committee is to provide all possible assistance for the welfare of the students. Keeping this view, the Committee decided to provide financial assistance to the economically weaker students during the year 2020. The funds for this purpose were mobilized through the voluntary contribution of teaching faculty. The task of identifying the economically weaker students was given to all mentors under the Mentorship Programme. A total of 20(twenty) students were identified by mentors, out of which 16 were selected by the welfare committee after proper scrutiny. A financial assistance of Rs. 600/-(six hundred Rupees) per beneficiary was given during this period. A total of Rs. 12,000/- (twelve thousand) only was granted under this scheme during the year 2020.
