Extension service to Bethel Children's Home

On 13th April 2024, Sao Chang College Students' Union visited 'Bethel Children's Home' as a part of extension activity by the student community. The Home provides shelter, education and emotional support to the underprivileged children of the neighbourhood. 'Bethel Children's Home' is run through charity by a local philanthropist and assisted by Ms. Ason Oungh Chang as the warden. The purpose of the visit was to interact as well as realise the difficult circumstances faced by the children aged between 4-17 years living in the children home. During the interaction with the children, it was learned that most of them had lost their parents and had no one to look after them. They had been placed in the home to receive basic needs, including food, shelter, and education. Despite their difficult circumstances, the children were incredibly resilient, hopeful, and eager to learn. A short program was conducted after which various activities including playing games, teaching them basic English, and having conversations which was followed by a mass feast. The visit to the Children's Trust Home highlighted the essential role it played in the lives of the underprivileged children. While the staffs' commitment to the children's well-being is commendable, the trust home requires additional support to overcome the challenges it faces. By addressing these needs, the home can continue to provide a safe, supportive environment that fosters the holistic development of each child.
