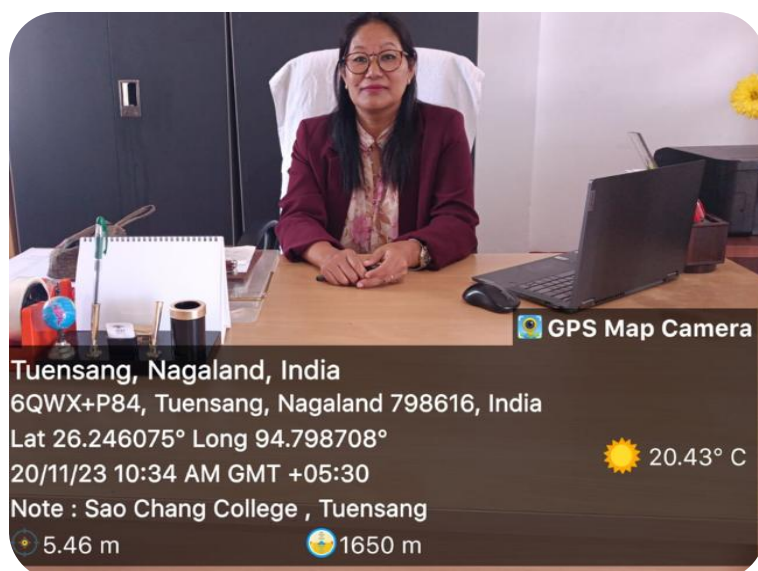
INSTITUTIONAL DATA

A brief background of the college

Sao Chang College is named after Lt. H. Sao Chang, former Minister of Transport & Communication and PHED, Government of Nagaland. The cherished aspiration for higher education of the people of Tuensang District saw its light with a humble beginning christened as “Tuensang Night College” (Arts) in the year 1975 at a designated temporary building in Tuensang Town. To accommodate the increasing enrollment of students seeking for higher education within the district, the college was elevated to a regular day-shift college. Subsequently the college was taken over by the Government of Nagaland in April 1983. Science stream was later introduced in 2005.

Shifted in the year 1996, the college now has its own permanent campus at a distance of about 9 Kilometres away from the town. Located amidst splendid and lofty mountain ranges and a pervading atmosphere of serenity, the college is ideal and conducive to be a centre of higher learning.

The college is co-educational. It imparts undergraduate programs in Arts and Science stream as per provision of NEP-2020. It is affiliated to the Nagaland University.

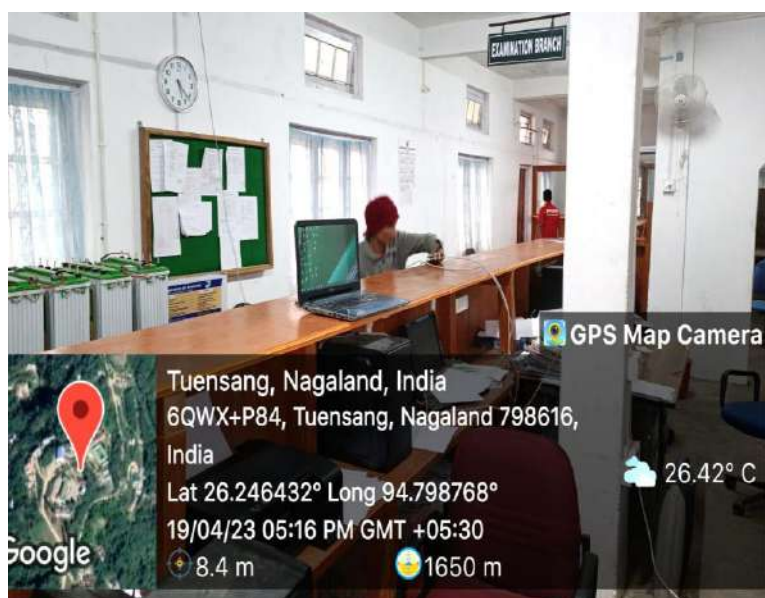

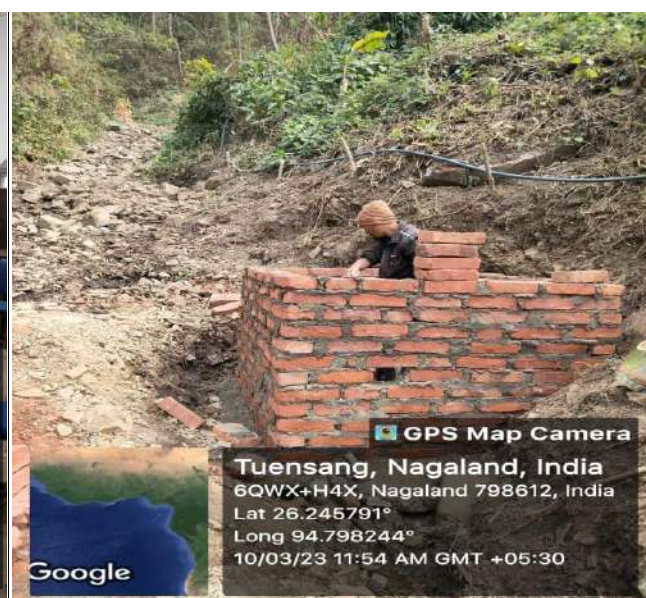
