Description:

The Coordinator Jal Shakti Committee, presenting on the Theme *Water for Peace* presented the concept behind the observation of World Water Day 2024, in the college.

He emphasised on the importance of freshwater and the need to conserve it; the scope of fresh water to create global collaboration and foster peace among nations or the conflict. Based on the theme, he encouraged the participants to reflect on the relationship between water, conflict, and cooperation; called to take a pledge and commit to participate in mission towards water conservation at local level, which will have far reaching global implications.










Newspaper coverage
