**Justification:** A teacher has to attend a minimum of one orientation & two refresher course of two to three week duration, and one faculty development related programme of one week duration with total of 70 points (20 + 20 + 20 + 10) during the period of Assistant professorship.

**Definition used: JS**- Joint Supervisor; **I**- Principal Investigator; **Co-PI**- Co-Principal Investigator; **ACM**- Advisory Council member; **AS**- Associating Scientist; **RA**- Research Associate; **SRA**- Senior Research Associate; **SRF**- Senior Research Fellow.

It is incumbent on the IQAC proposed in these rules and the College to prepare and publish within six months subject-wise list of journal, periodicals and publishers under categories IIIA and B. till such time Screening Committee will verify the categorization scores of the publications.
