Report on: WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 2023

Joining the global event, the World Environment Day 2023 was observed at GMS Chendang village Tuensang, organised by the Dept. of Environmental Science and the Dept. of Zoology, Sao Chang College, Tuensang.

As an extension service, the event was marked by conducting a Seminar on Solution to Plastic Pollution, with participants from School Management Committee and School Parents association and also conducting a Plantation drive.

Objective:

Addressing the issues of Plastic Pollution and Environmental Degradation.

Description:

The extension program was held at GMS Chendang village, Tuensang.

A seminar was organized for members of the School Management Committee (SMC) and the Parents' Association, centered around the theme "Solution to Plastic Pollution." The event, conducted in the local dialect, featured Ms. Rangbenkumla Chang, Assistant Professor in the Department of Environmental Science at Sao Chang College. She emphasized the need to reduce reliance on plastic materials in our daily lives and highlighted the importance of efficient waste management to foster a clean and hygienic environment at the village level.

In the second session, Ms. Vidila Jing, Assistant Professor in the Department of Zoology at Sao Chang College, underscored the significance of tree planting and the responsibility of acting as stewards of God's creation. Collaborating with B.Sc. students, she led a plantation drive activity for school students. Noteworthy contributions were made by Sir Alemwapang ACF (DFO Longleng), who generously provided plantation saplings, and the Yingli Mission Society Nagaland, which partly sponsored the event

Outcome:

During the event, the School Management Committee, Parents, and Students gained insights into the significance of discouraging the use of plastic carry bags and related materials. The session emphasized the prolonged decomposition period of plastic and its detrimental effects on the ecosystem. Additionally, the seminar delved into the health consequences of using plastic products, shedding light on key issues arising from water and air pollution. The discussion also explored innovative approaches for materia reuse and recycling. Notably, the occasion saw the planting of around 40 saplings, including water-retention, fruit-bearing, and ornamental trees.
